GREAT FALLS HIGH SCHOOL SYMPHONIC BAND

Great Falls High School is a four-year high school with an enrollment of over 1,800 students, with nearly 550 young people involved in the study of music through performance and classroom study. The Choral Department includes eight performing choirs which meet daily. Aeolian, Lyric and Varsity Choirs are 9th grade choirs; the Concert Choir and Chorale are grades 10-12 training choirs; the Select Women's Choir is made up of advanced sophomores, juniors and seniors; the Delphian Choir and the Chamber Singers represent the select choral groups. The Instrumental Department includes the Varsity Band, the Concert Band, the select Symphonic Band and the Blue Notes Jazz Band. The string program is made up of the String Ensemble, a training group which is prerequisite to the String orchestra. Music Theory and Music Appreciation are non-performance course offerings available to all advanced music students. Handbells have been offered at Great Falls High School since 1985. The program currently consists of beginning and intermediate level choirs as well as the GFHS Handbell Choir, which includes the most experienced ringers. Handbell students are drawn from all areas of the music department.
